**EASY STEPS TO DETERMINE IF
PUBLIC NOTICE IN AN ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE IS REQUIRED**

Public notice rules require you to determine whether notice in an alternative language in an alternative language publication is required.

FYI

Effective September 1, 2006, the TCEQ will no longer issue, amend, or renew permits, registrations, certifications, or licenses to an entity or person who is delinquent on any administrative penalties or fees.**

- **We will not declare any application administratively complete** that is submitted by a person or entity who is delinquent on a fee or administrative penalty until the fee/penalty is paid, or if on an approved installment plan, that payments under the plan are current.
- **We will withhold final action on an application** if we discover after the application is considered administratively complete that the owner or entity who submitted the application is delinquent on a fee or administrative penalty until the fee/penalty is paid and the account is current.
